

Master Section

(To maintain consistency)

It is common to observe that faculty proposes a lot of good suggestions about how to engage students more productively, policies and procedures. But left alone to faculty, in most cases, they do what they feel comfortable with. **Educosoft Master Section** concept ensures strict implementation of the consensus of the Department that helps in maintaining uniform pace of instruction, learning and assessment policies across various groups of students with fairness and ease of control.

The master section is created by an authorized instructor (designated as Course Coordinator) responsible for getting consensus among key teachers in terms of policies, practices, course outlines, classroom activities, assessments and evaluations. The course coordinator implements these common rules and guidelines through permissions in a master section. The components of the master section are pushed to all sections of the course. The coordinator can, however, activate or block certain flexibility on any individual section if need arises.

What Master Section concept means
